Fermentation: Destemmed and crushed into open-top fermenters. Hand plunged or pumped over twice daily. Pressed off skins after 13-18 days.

Titrateable Acidity: 5.7

ABV: 13.7%

Tasting Notes: Aromas of black cherry, plum, blackberry, dried herbs, and mint. Flavors of cherry, blackberry, and blueberry. Medium-full bodied, moderately high acidity. Excellent paired with food or on its own. Long, rich finish and silky tannins.
