



2024 “Dala” Chardonnay

Arizona White Wine

Varieties: 100% Chardonnay

Growing Region: Willcox American Viticultural Area

Vineyard Source: Bonita Springs Vineyard

Vineyard Elevation: 4,350 feet

Vineyard Soil Type: Silty clay loam

Vine Age: 32 years

Fermentation: Whole-cluster pressed to a temperature-controlled stainless steel tank. After fermentation was initiated, 25% of the total volume was sent to neutral barrel for added texture. After fermentation completed, the barrel-fermented and tank-fermented portions were blended back together in stainless steel for aging. No malolactic fermentation.

Elevage: Aged in stainless steel for 7 months.

pH at Bottling: 3.59

Titrateable Acidity: 5.5

ABV: 12.7%

Cases Produced: 224

Winemaker: Jason McCluskey

Tasting Notes: Bright and clean with pear, green apple, white flower, and citrus aromas. On the palate, lemon curd, melon, and pear are carried by bright acidity and prominent minerality.
